On the day the plant was presented for judging, it displayed approximately 85 inflorescences spread evenly around the base of the plant, with 69 fully open flowers and approximately 77 buds. Dorsal sepal yellow dotted purple, more densely at apex; lateral sepals fused, yellow dotted purple; cushions yellow, finely dotted purple; pale yellow sepaline tails, fimbriate; petals yellow; lavender lip; purple column; substance firm with a crystalline texture. A very good example of this species.

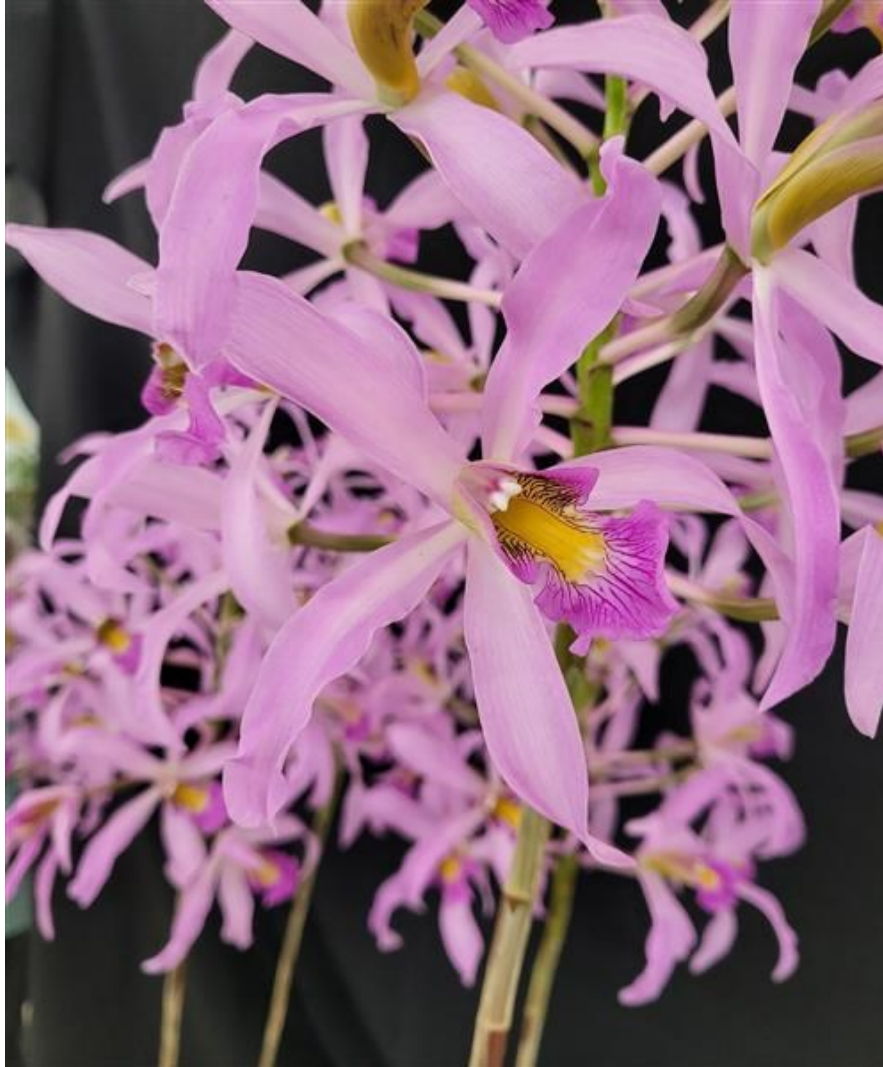

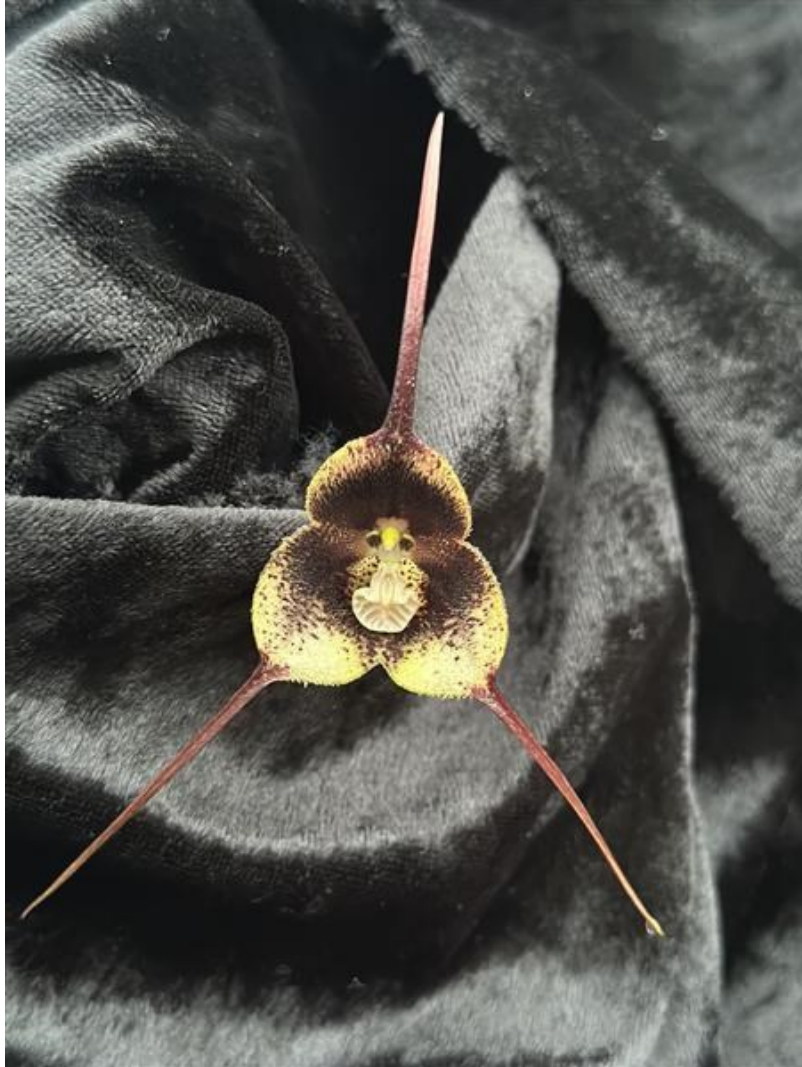
