John Easton Award 2022

From its inception in 1976 until June 2022, the John Easton Award was administered by the Hawke's Bay Orchid Society. However, in 2022 HBOS asked OCNZ to take on the award, presented for the most outstanding contribution to the culture and promotion of orchids in New Zealand. OCNZ has great pleasure in announcing Chris Hubbert as recipient of the 2022 award.

A full report will be in *Orchids 2023*, but some highlights are: Chris was chair of the Northern Regional Judging Group from 2008-2020, and chair of the Committee on Awards (COA) 2021-22. Last month, the COA elevated Chris to Senior Judge in recognition of his outstanding service. He has been editor of the North Shore Orchid Society's *Insigne* newsletter for 28 years, and a long-serving committee member. Chris joined the OCNZ Executive in 2015 as Treasurer, a position he held until late 2022.
