Vice-presidents: John Mason, Norm Wood. Secretary/treasurer: Syd Wray. Committee: Bryan Clark, Bruce Douglas. A look back at OCNZ's first 50 years – and some of the milestones achieved over that time – will be in the 2026 Yearbook.
